INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF NSEDC/NSSP RADIO REPEATER SYSTEM

In order to connect* to the NSEDC/NSSP radio repeater, a vessel marine Motorola radio is recommended. However, an in-house radio user may also have a Kenwood radio. All radios must be programmed to the right frequency to work.

Turn on radio and program to the following frequency:

Repeater A – Search & Rescue

Rx 158.82 MHz Tx 153.815 MHz (That is a -5.005 shift)

Repeater B – NSEDC/NSSP Fishing Fleet

Rx 158.22 MHz Tx 153.125 MHz (That is a -5.095 shift)

Repeater Locations: Mountain 2211 in T9S

R21W Sec 24 of the Kateel River Meridian
